Except that right now, he doesn't



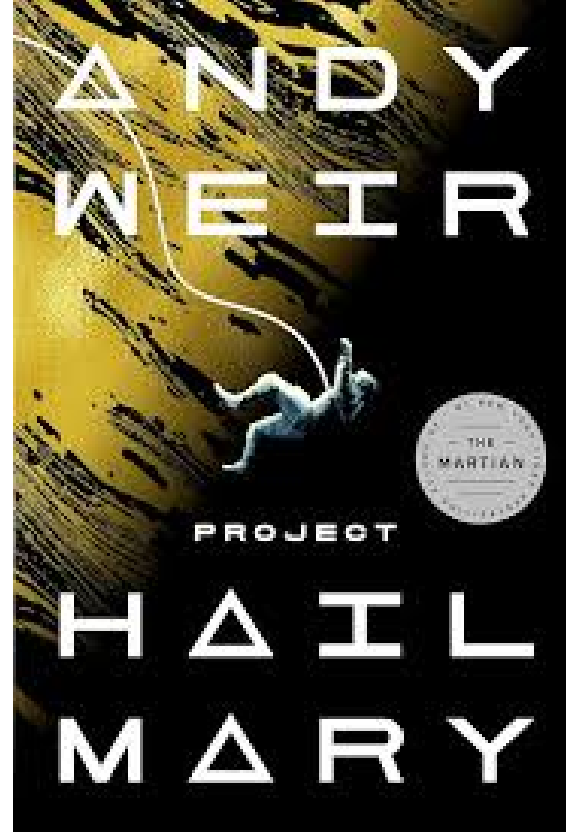
know that. He can't even remember his own name, let alone the nature of his assignment or how to complete it.
